Narrative:

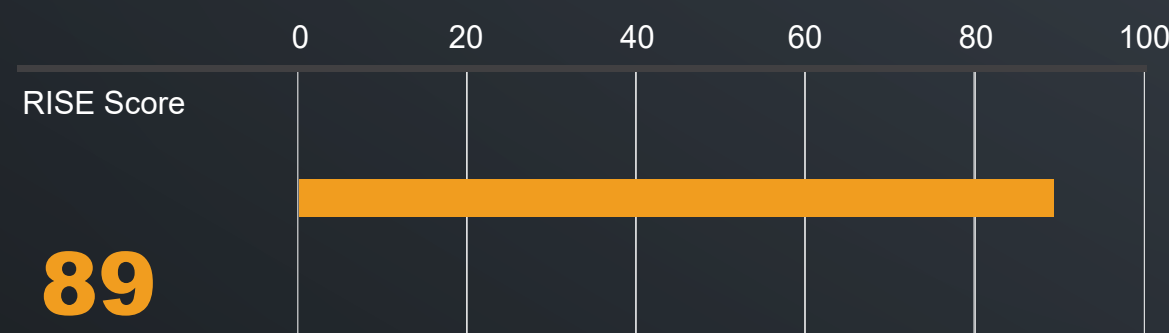
Tanzania has a large off-grid population as only 17% of rural households have access to electricity. The Rural Energy Agency plans to electrify 85% of all villages by 2025 and achieve 100% by 2030.

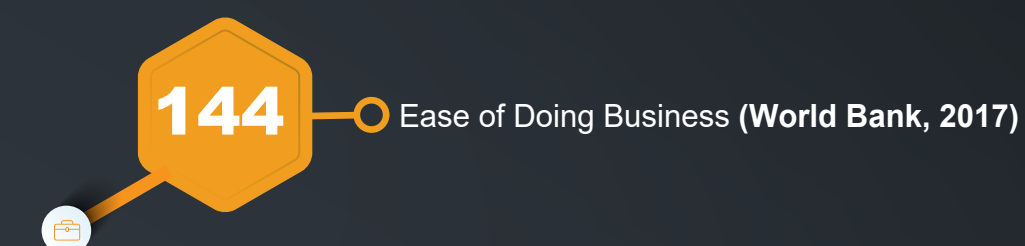

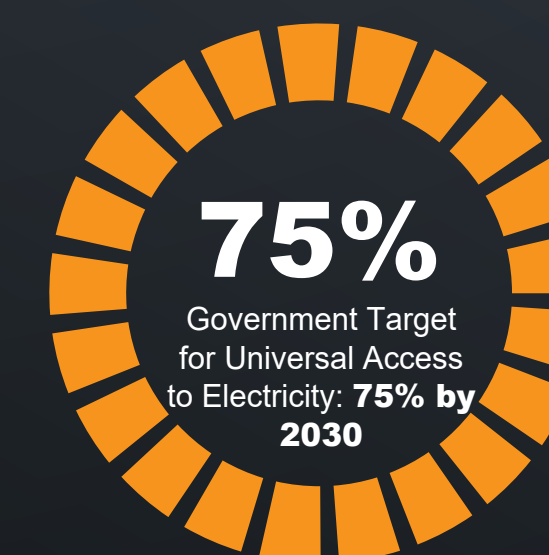
